 $\underline{V.2}$ - 'Maintain an earnest persistence in prayer while remaining alert and in an attitude of thankfulness.'

While staying aware of their life situations...

- ...remaining ever thankful to God because you **KNOW** He hears, He cares, and He will act.
- Luke 18:1-8 Jesus taught His disciples that, "they should always pray and not give up."
- $\underline{\text{Vv.3-4}}$ A good example of how we should pray for ourselves and one another with regard to our sharing endeavors.
 - That God would orchestrate opportunities for our witness.
- For God to enable us to clearly reveal ('make manifest') the mystery of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
- $\underline{\text{V.5}}$ Exercise godly wisdom in the way you live so that unbelievers who see you and how you live may be drawn to faith in God by your life.
- As Paul taught in Romans and Galatians, we must live by the Holy Spirit of God and not by the flesh.
- Then, exercising that godly wisdom, make the most of the sharing opportunities God provides.
 - Ephesians 5:15-16
- $\underline{\text{V.6}}$ Let your speech be always with the graciousness that reflects Christlikeness...
- ...love, humility, compassion and respect for the one with whom you are speaking.
- "Seasoned with salt" = Our speech is to be wholesome, inoffensive, pleasant, flavorful, lively and enthusiastic.

Trust that God will orchestrate the pursuit unto salvation, as demonstrated in Acts 10 and Acts 16.
