Isaiah 7:14

God Himself was going to some day come down from heaven to be *with* them to save them!

Isaiah 9:6-7

 $\underline{V.6}$ - He will be sovereign, omniscient, all wise, omnipotent, eternal, one with our Father God, and provider of our eternal peace with God.

 $\underline{V.7}$ - Nothing will ever be able to disrupt the full expanse of His Kingdom and perfect peace.

- His eternal reign will be the ultimate fulfillment of God's covenant promises to Abraham, David and us.

- The irresistible, invincible, passionate love and resolute determination of the Lord of Hosts will make His plan come to be.

God's Advent promises - the fulfillment of His first Advent and the certainty of His second - guarantee our eternal salvation!

Jesus IS our hope, peace, joy, love, light, salvation and Christmas hope!
