Acts 2:14-41

The bottom line here was that Peter preached Jesus.

As Luke tells us in verses 5-11 of this chapter...

There were Jews from "every nation under heaven".

The miracle was that they all heard these Galileans proclaiming the wonders of God in their own respective native languages.

- Coupled with Jesus' Great Commission in Matthew 28:19 and Jesus' instruction in Acts 1:8 gives the clear picture that the Gospel is for EVERY ethnicity, race, tribe, color, man, woman, boy and girl.

- Then Peter preaches Jesus, and salvation through Him.

The point? Jesus is for EVERYONE!

Why? Every person is special to God and Jesus is the ONLY answer for sin, and Jesus is the ONLY true source of justice, unity, peace, enlightenment, and love.

Jesus is the light of the world; the light of Jesus lives in believers; His light and love are to shine out from our lives.

- You and I need to be going to people and telling them about Jesus.

- You and I need to continuously seek to allow the light and love of Jesus to shine out from our lives.

- You and I need to be living like Jesus.

- 1 John 2:6

That means to live our lives the way Jesus would live our lives.

Shine, Jesus, Shine out from our lives! And may I not hinder you and your light and your love in any way.
